I support coverage of abortion services by government health care-including but not limited to Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries, U.S. servicemembers and veterans, and government employees-and I oppose the Hyde amendment and related abortion coverage bans. I also support expanded access to medication abortion care and oppose efforts to limit its availability through bans on off-label use, telemedicine, mailing across state lines, or other restrictions.
